

Target Giving Circle Participation Instructions

About Target Giving Circle:

WRCD was selected as one of five organizations in Washington to be a part of [Target Circle's Community Giving](#). Members of Target Circle are able to cast votes to direct where funds go in support of nonprofits in their community and across the nation. At the end of the voting period (July 1-September 30), Target awards grants to the nonprofits based on the percentage of votes they receive.

With each purchase, Target Circle members accumulate votes. If you shop at Target, please consider casting votes for WRCD to support us in continuing our salmon habitat restoration and wildfire resilience work in Washington. If you have friends or family who shop at Target, feel free to forward the following instructions and encourage them to vote!

Earning Votes:

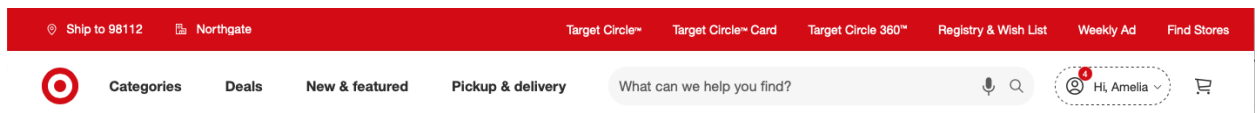
You can earn votes by making purchases in-store, on the website, or in the app.

**If shopping in-store, make sure to enter your phone number at the register to earn votes. You can also add the receipt online within 7 days.*

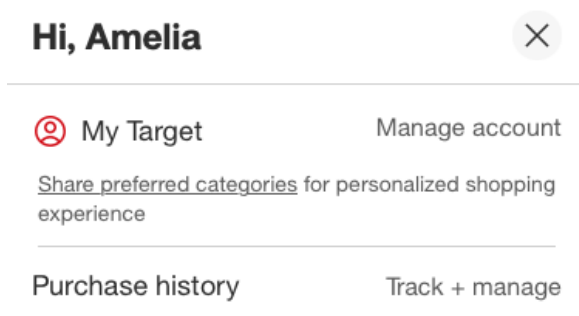
**If shopping online or in the app, make sure you're logged into your Target Circle account.*

How to Vote on the Target Website:

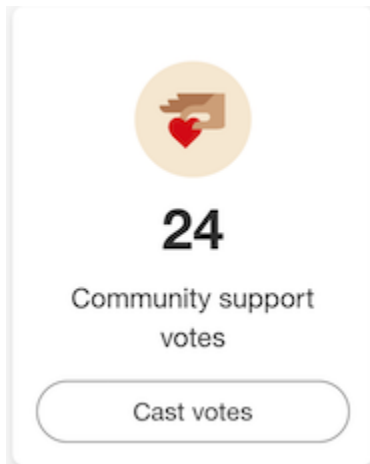
1. **Log in** to your Target Circle account (or create one if you don't have one).
2. Once logged in, **click on the profile icon** (a person in a circle) at the top of the homepage



3. **Select "Manage Account"**



4. Scroll down to the box that shows how many “community support votes” you have and click **"cast votes"**




5. Scroll through the options (there are 5), and choose to **cast your votes** for WRCD!

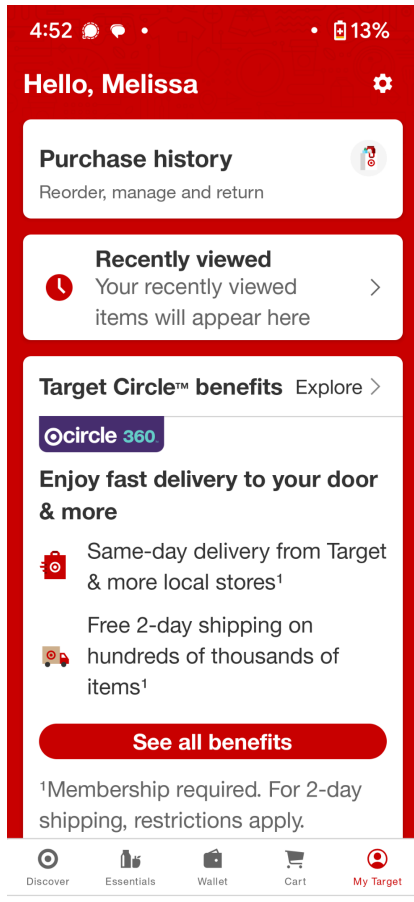

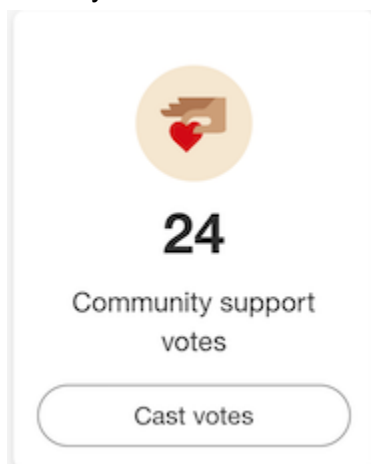

How to Vote on the Target App:

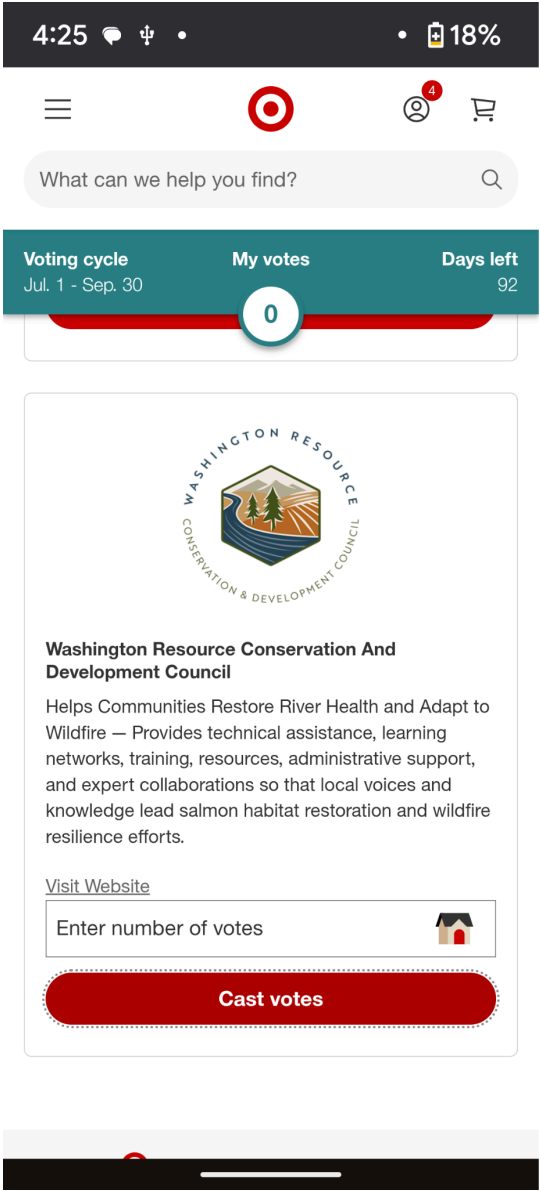
1. Log into the Target app. **Click "My Target"** icon at the bottom right
2. After "Purchase History" and "Recently Viewed", **click on "Explore"** in the "Target Circle benefits" section



3. On the next screen, scroll down to the box that shows how many "community support votes" you have and **click "cast votes"**



4. Scroll through the options (there are 5), and choose to **cast your votes** for WRCD!



Frequently Asked Questions

How many votes do I earn?

You earn one vote per purchase on qualified items.

What if I don't live in Washington?

Even if you don't live within the regions in which WRCD is represented (all of Washington except the southwestern region), you can still vote for us. On the Target website, you can change your zip-code and store of choice in the top lefthand corner. Enter the zip code: 98901 and select a Target near Yakima, WA before going to cast votes.
